Drug & Alcohol Policy

In line with ECB guidance on the requirements of all senior clubs to have policies in areas of significance, please be aware of Greenfield Cricket & Social Clubs policy on drug use.

This is a clear and important statement that is kept deliberately concise - please take a moment to read it and share.

'The Cricket Management Committee wishes to state that Greenfield Cricket & Social Club operates a zero tolerance policy to illegal drug use from members and their guests when on our premises.

We are a family club, with a clear responsibility to ensure that all members - young and old - are not exposed to illegal behaviour on the club premises or when representing our club. We also secure the future of our club by operating it as a business and illegal drug use on the premises puts the licenses to run this business, and by extension the club's future, at risk.

These are risks we are not willing to take.

Any persons who are found to have taken, brought or supplied illegal substances on the clubs premises or any location where the club is participating will be banned for life from the club and have all details of the offence presented to the police to enforce such a stance as we seek to preserve the good name and sporting traditions of Greenfield Cricket Club

We hope and trust that neither of these measures will ever be required and that the zero tolerance approach is understood by all.

Alcohol Policy

Any persons who are seen or found to have purchased or provided alcoholic drinks to underage children while at the club will be asked to leave the premises and may be banned for life from the club should the committee deem fit to do so.

Greenfield Cricket & Social Club wish to remind all players, parents and guests that underage drinking will not be allowed under any circumstances in line with the licence the club has with the local authority
